



It is hard to believe that the financial crisis that affected so many homeowners and communities throughout the country started nine years ago. While foreclosure rates are down and people are back to work, there are still thousands of people that are forced to live in substandard single-family housing. Even though they are working, their wages haven't risen, their medical bills are increasing, and ultimately, they cannot afford the critical repairs and modifications needed for their homes to be safe and healthy. The luxury of a home and the American Dream is still not affordable.

This was the case for the Vang family. But, because of the support of a sponsor like you, we were able to replace their roof and gutters. Their basement has since dried up, and their children are experiencing fewer respiratory problems. Now they spend less on repairs and medical bills leaving money for other important expenses. The Vangs say, *"It is such a blessing and relief to know that the roof will keep the house dry. Thank you."*

Livability Tasks:

- Interior and Exterior Painting
- Floor Repair or Replacement
- Window Replacement
- General Landscaping
- Sidewalk Repair

Accessibility Tasks:

- Ramp Construction
- Grab Bars Installation
- Handrail Installation

Community Tasks:

- Exterior Painting
- Community Garden Construction
- Native Landscape Restoration
- Outdoor Classroom Construction
- Public Park Playground Installation

* Please note that Rebuilding Together Twin Cities will not ask volunteers to complete tasks that would typically require a contractor. When resources allow, contractors are hired to complete complex, plumbing, electrical, structural, outer envelope or HVAC tasks.

We encourage partnering teams to identify the following volunteer leaders:



Volunteer and Community Builder Awards




Rebuilding Together Twin Cities presents two Awards each year to volunteers and companies that exemplify outstanding support of affordable, safe and healthy housing.


